## Sectional Guidelines:

All Band Sectionals will begin at **8:00 a.m. or 4:15 p.m.** Please be on time, in your seat with instrument, all music, and pencil. The side Band Hall door will be opened for morning sectional students to enter.

Sectionals are graded events. If you are absent from school (for more than 1-2 periods) on a sectional day you will be allowed to make up your sectional. Please see Mr. Anderson/Mr. Summerhays/Mr. Valdez to make arrangements within two days of your absence. It is YOUR responsibility to seek out a make-up time/assignment.

I will do my best to NOT change your sectional day. Please take that into consideration when you schedule doctor/dentist/orthodontist appointments. Those will not be excused absences. If you receive a detention, please communicate with the assigning teacher that you have a sectional and politely ask for a different day. Please refer the teacher to Mr. Anderson/Mr. Summerhays/Mr. Valdez if they have any questions.

Athletes, it is your responsibility to communicate your sectional time/day with your coaches. This will be an excused absence from practice, but you need to make sure the coaches know where you are.
